- Faculty/Staff looking to replace screens with fun events i.e. pop-up events, performances, etc
- Faculty/Staff will have phones all day, on them but not using during instructional time unless for school related issue:
- Every classroom has a hard-wired phone system w/ speaker/intercom

- School intends to do a poll in October to see how things are going; will revisit later part of the year as well
- School installed analog clocks in every classroom; will also install clocks in dining and servery areas (digital)
