Dr. Dan Wagner, School Counselor for the lower school, is a psychologist who focuses on the socialemotional learning of our children. He goes into classrooms and leads activities for social-emotional learning and mindfulness. He not only teaches social-emotional development, he collaborates with teachers on a general level. The children get to know him. He also works with individual students as a resource in this challenging and competitive academic environment. He is there to provide extra support for managing bumps in the road as an advocate, cheerleader, and strategist. In addition to academic support, he provides social support and validation to help our children navigate friendships and bullying by facilitating small groups and open discussions. Can also work with outside therapists. Dr. Dan actively works to reduce the stigma of going to the school counselor within the student body. He is present in the classrooms and developing relationships to normalize his position in the school as a resource for support.
