In 1997, **Gerald Martindale** became carillonneur at the historic Metropolitan United Church of Toronto. Upon retirement in 2016, he began to play the Exhibition Place carillon. He studied with Dr. Sydney Shep, former carillonneur of the University of Toronto. He earned a Bachelor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Windsor and holds Associate Diplomas in Organ from the Royal Conservatory of Music of Toronto and the Royal Canadian College of Organists. Martindale sings in 2 community choirs and is active as a tenor sub and supply organist. For the past 26 years, he has been actively engaged as a background performer, having acted in 364 movie and television productions. He has completed 22 concert tours of the United States and 11 tours of Europe. Last summer, he performed 15 recitals in Denmark, Sweden, Germany, Austria, and France.
