Upper School Update:

Merritt Livermore, Head of Upper School-- French exchange students- 24 students and 3 teachers from France coming into Dulles today; Course registration materials are out, registration starts Thursday to select courses, print out form and have teachers, advisors, college counselors, deans sign off; Sophomore college counselor meetings are this week and next; Parent Teacher conferences are Thursday night and will continue even with a delay of school start; Leadership opportunities were explained to students with decisions in April (Honor Council, Class leadership positions, rising Seniors interested in RL, etc.); Robotics going to Virginia Tech; School day on Easter Monday, will be a modified schedule and will work with students who maybe absent; April Fools Day is on Easter Sunday so US is celebrating on April 3rd, Andy Hilgartner working with Seniors for "good, clean fun"; Sophomore "stay safe" date changed to Wed, April 4th for parents and students of Sophomores; Student productions in spring; Lisa Winters Roboticist speaker and workshops for students; PROM coming up

Q- Will we get out early today? A: We may cancel after school activities today because of snow Q-Is there anything online about the new houses and STEM/SEED building? A: Faculty housing ready by August 1st; Fader Innovation Center will be opening summer 2018 for Robotics, engineering, SEED (Social Entrepreneurial, Engineering, Design program), students can be eligible to take 1-3 year(s) program depending on when students enter program with 3 teachers (Match Zimmerman, Steve Eno, Ned Courtemanche) hoping to have more students in program than were allowed in Engineering class; building used in evening for extra curricular programs; FRC and FTC (middle and upper school versions); the past engineering class is wrapped into this program/course; McDonogh Works program with contracting company going into building this Thursday

Q- Would you explain the new technology during lockdowns? A: "Pinpoint" Jack Hardcastle and Rick Landsman created this system and sends a message to all cell phones registered, link takes to website that asks McDonogh specific questions, helps to indicate who the students are with, building students are located in; software assimilates the information to account for everyone; sign up for weather alert and will get the pinpoint info; register cell numbers on DASH/ personal page

Q- Is there more security and are they armed? A: yes, there now are 3 security guards on duty during school day, 2 guards until boarders are locked in dorms, 1 security guard from 11pm-6am; yes, some are armed as they are retired or off-duty police officers, their guns are supposed to be concealed; one guard does not have a gun; all faculty/staff are now wearing badges to help students identify who to ask for help Q- Have we had any student walkouts in support of anti-guns or is there McDonogh transportation to the DC rally March 24th? A-Michele McFarland and John Wood working with students, but no organized bus provided; there have not been any student walk-outs

Q- How are students recommended for upcoming classes A: The recommended classes are on the students' DASH and can speak with advisors.
