

McDonogh Parents Association Upper School Meeting Minutes September 12th, 2017 8:30 am; 33 attendees

Welcome and Introductions: Jill Eisner, Chair Kristin Henry, Assistant Chair

Upper School Update:

Charlie Britton- pleased to be coming back for next year; really appreciates the relationship with MPA; door is always open, please come into office to bring up ideas/concerns/suggestion; 38 teacher townhomes going up in next few weeks for faculty and staff (\$6 million donor); Fader Innovation Center for engineering, robotics, automotive by January 2018; New Middle School fundraising \$25-28 million-largest in MD; History House is going to be built up Shell Road from Bowman, raised \$1m; deeper learning starting in classrooms

Merritt Livermore, Head of Upper School- SWOT (Strengths, Weakness, Opportunities, Threats) brainstorming meeting relayed that faculty really appreciate the MPA /US relationships; Sage decided nut/peanut butter free school now because of serious health concerns of students - PB replaced by Sunflower butter and "wow- soy" butter; revamped parking concern will be re-evaluated in 6 weeks; Each Class had a retreat being re-evaluated; students watched video about 9-11 student hockey player volunteer firefighter "red bandana", very moving; club fair starts soon; Donations for Harvey/Irma became the "red white and blue day" today for all three divisions participating with culminating donation to American Red Cross on Friday; her door is always open, please come visit to see how they can better support students

Alex Gardner, Freshman Dean- last year class was 164; this year class is 154, which is "better number and easier to get to know students"; Alex's office is now in basement and new Freshman lounge is now across from school store; Alex is proctoring all study halls with lounge chairs and two round tables which is helping with students' schedules; He is visiting all classes which Freshman can take and observes students in classroom setting; Today's newsletter has "Parenting your Freshman" facilitated by Michelle Kriebel on Wed, Oct 11th; PSAT Oct.11th for Soph/Junior ½ day-Freshman activities maybe ½ day field trip to BMA team work and ½ day service project tied to English book "Salvage the Bones"; Alex is first point person for tutoring, student issues, ect.
